## **A Central Government Road Safety Strategy**

It would appear that Westminster has no current strategy for Road Safety in place other than for the military. Such is the conclusion of Dr. Ian Greenwood, a Road Safety campaigner.

Nick Lyes, IAM's Policy and Standards Director expresses the deep concern Road Safety Organisations have at this lack of policy and will continue to push the Government to provide an update.


