SMART Motorways rule change



GBD Rescue and Recovery has announced an update indicating that officials will no longer close a smart motorway lane using the Red X to allow traffic rejoining. Rather than completely closing a lane to enable breakdown crews and motorists to safely accelerate to motorway speeds, traffic will be directed across using a diverted arrow. The intention is to let a gap develop naturally, yet specialists caution that this approach may not suffice and could result in severe consequences. Another bright idea!

There are strong rumours that Pay-per-Mile will replace the existing Vehicle Excise Duty in the forthcoming budget.


