

#### **Graduated Licences**

A graduated driving licence would put a set of restrictions on new drivers who have recently passed their theory test and practical exam, for an initial period of time.

Kim Leadbeater MP recently proposed a Bill into Parliament which has received cross-party support and industry support and will now progress to a Second reading on Friday 17 May.



#### Intelligent Speed Assistant (ISA)

From July all new cars must be equipped with Intelligent Speed Assistance (ISA) technology by law. ISA helps drivers stay within speed limits by actively assisting them. ISA relies on information from GPS mapping and road sign recognition although it can be switched off at the start of a journey.


